**UK Cardiff** - Mike Fedeski - [From street sounds to dance music](#) - 19' - 2017 - audio

The soundscape compositions on this map are rhythmic mixes of street sounds collected in Grangetown by residents, who were asked to sample distinctive sounds evoking impressions of their neighbourhood. After Elmono's mix, the compositions were played back to the residents at a 'listening', which presented them with a reinterpretation of the everyday sounds they are accustomed to hear around their homes. Play time is 19 minutes, but take about an hour to get to know the neighbourhood.

This project is still underway. Five compositions are published here initially, and others will be added over the coming weeks. The work is being undertaken as part of a citizen science project funded by Cardiff University called Mobile Crowdsensing. It ran in Grangetown through last year. Residents were working with scientists and artists to evaluate the quality of their environment. The sound group was led by listeninggreen and has been encouraging residents to listen to the sounds around them.
